Scripture: Genesis 5:29; 6:8-10; Heb. 11:7 (NKJV).

Gen 5:29 And he called his name Noah, saying, "This one will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the Lord has cursed." **Gen 9:1, 20-22 (11)** So God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them: "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth. **20** And Noah began to be a farmer, and he planted a vineyard. **21** Then he drank of the wine and was drunk, and became uncovered in his tent. **22** And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brothers outside. **Gen 9:24-25 (24)** So Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what his younger son had done to him. **25** Then he said: "Cursed be Canaan; A servant of servants He shall be to his brethren."

Gal 3:13-14 (13) Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), **14** that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. NKJV
