1 Cor. 11:23-30 (NKJV)(KJV)



LEADER: (11:23)

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread;

CONGREGATION: (11:24)

and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

LEADER: (11:25)

In the same manner, *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me."

CONGREGATION: (11:26)

For as often as you eat this bread and drink *this* cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

LEADER: (11:27)

Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks *this* cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

CONGREGATION: (11:28)

But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

LEADER: (11:29)

For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. *(KJV)*

ALL: (11:30)

For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. *(KJV)*.

Scripture: Mark 16:2-7 (NKJV)

2 Very early in the morning, on the first day of the week, they came to the tomb when the sun had risen. **3** And they said among themselves, "Who will roll away the stone from the door of the tomb for us?" **4** But when they looked up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away — for it was very large. **5** And entering the tomb, they saw a young man clothed in a long white robe sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed. **6** But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He is risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him. **7** But go, tell His disciples — and Peter — that He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him, as He said to you." NKJV
